William J. "Bill" Griffith was born January 15, 1944 in Walnut, Iowa to William Lyle and Elsie Marie (Rihner) Griffith. He was one of seven children. He graduated from Walnut High School in 1961. Bill worked at Olsen Motors in Walnut, Iowa from 1961-1968. He then managed the Texaco Station by the interstate in Walnut from 1968-1972. Bill then worked for Chub Walter and Albert Schirm in the fertilizer business.

Bill was united into marriage to Opal Armstrong on June 12, 1965 at the Presbyterian Church in Walnut. After their honeymoon to Florida, they made their home in Walnut. They were the parents of three sons: Courtney, Adrian and Shannon.

Bill and Opal began their Antique business in the late 1970's and were engaged in it at the time of his passing.
